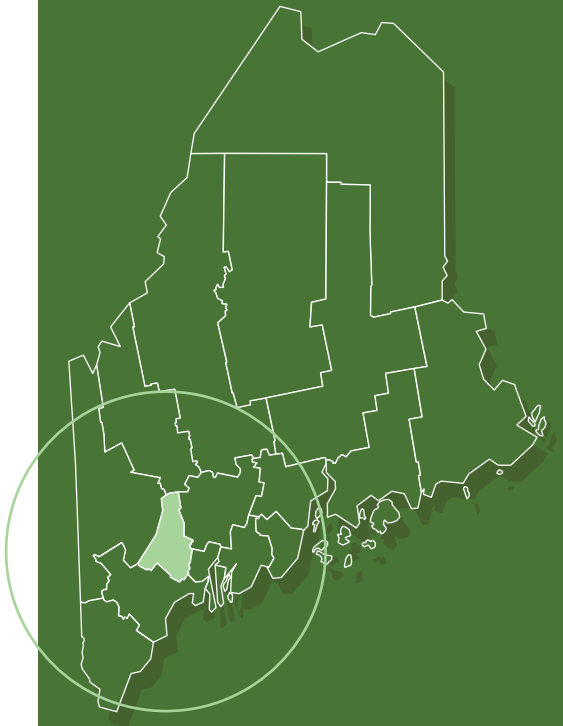

# Androscoggin

Every day, nutritious meals are missing from tables in Androscoggin County. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, **Androscoggin County is projected to rise to 15,290 food insecure residents in 2021** (14.2 percent of the county's population). Food insecurity among children is projected to be even higher at 20.7 percent, which is a 12 percent increase over 2019. Through our network of local food pantries, meal sites, shelters, and other organizations we provide food assistance to Mainers living in Androscoggin County.
