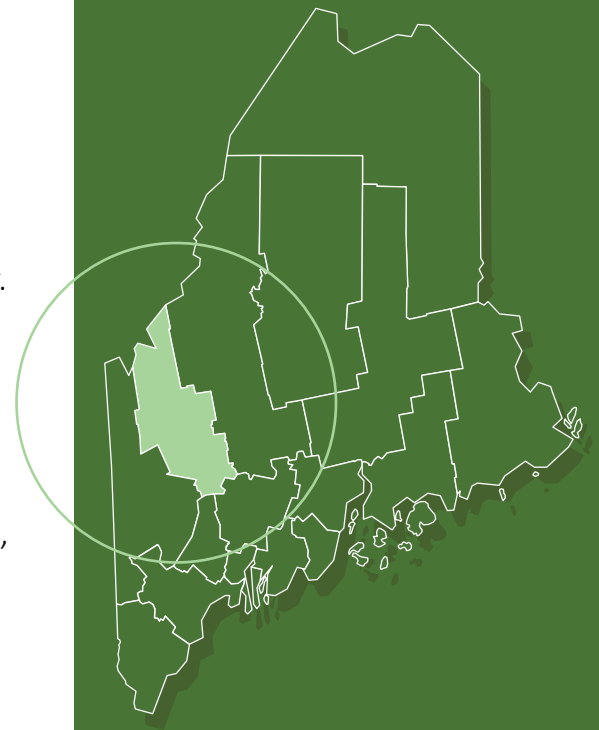


COUNTY INFORMATION

Franklin

Every day, nutritious meals are missing from tables in Franklin County. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, **Franklin County is projected to rise to 3,840 food insecure residents in 2021** (12.8 percent of the county's population). Food insecurity among children is projected to be even higher at 19.9 percent, which is an 8 percent increase over 2019. Through our network of local food pantries, meal sites, shelters, and other organizations we provide food assistance to Mainers living in Franklin County.
