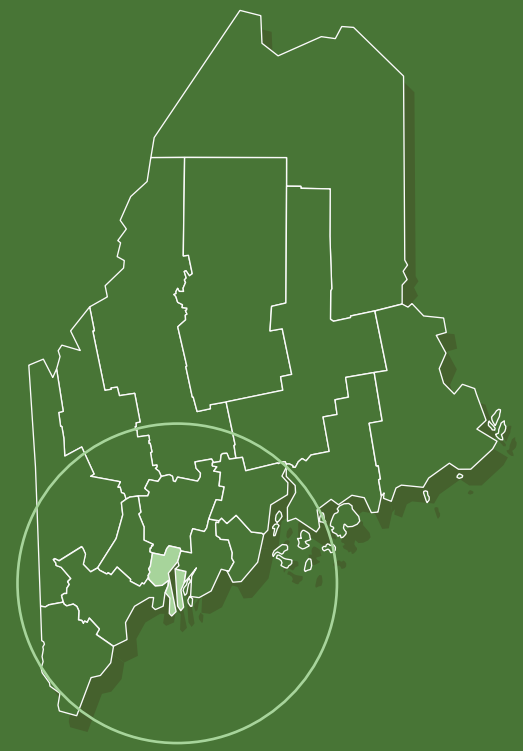


COUNTY INFORMATION

Sagadahoc

Every day, nutritious meals are missing from tables in Sagadahoc County. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, **Sagadahoc County is projected to rise to 4,090 food insecure residents in 2021** (11.5 percent of the county’s population). Food insecurity among children is projected to be even higher at 17.8 percent, which is a 13 percent increase over 2019. Through our network of local food pantries, meal sites, shelters, and other organizations we provide food assistance to Mainers living in Sagadahoc County.
