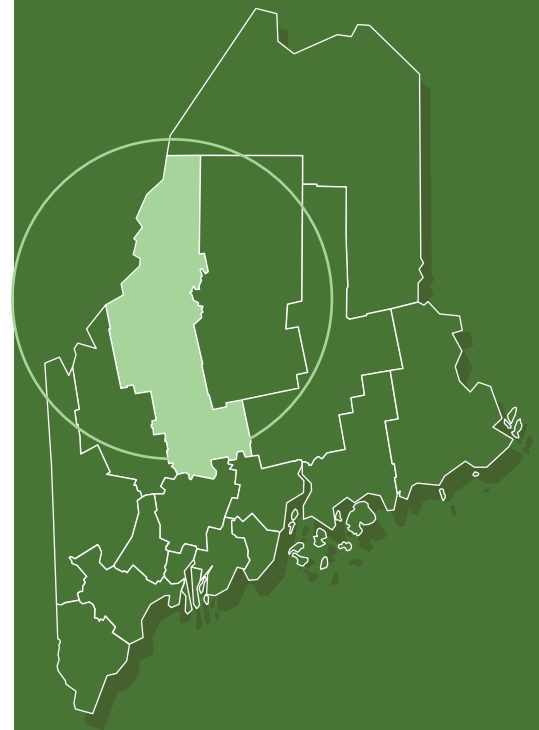


COUNTY INFORMATION

# Somerset

Every day, nutritious meals are missing from tables in Somerset County. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, **Somerset County is projected to rise to 9,210 food insecure residents in 2021** (18.2 percent of the county's population). Food insecurity among children is projected to be even higher at 28.3 percent, which is a 7 percent increase over 2019. Through our network of local food pantries, meal sites, shelters, and other organizations we provide food assistance to Mainers living in Somerset County.
